Drama After-School Club - Thursdays - Juniors

We have been lucky enough to organise an after-school Drama club for the Juniors which will be run by Anna Berentzen from Buxton Opera House. She will be coming in to school on Thursdays starting next week (14th Sept) and teaching the children about acting and stagecraft, hopefully culminating in a performance around Christmas time. The club will run from 3:30 to 4:30. Children attending may like to bring a snack and a drink but do not need anything else. There will be no charge. Homework
