Religious Education Policy – March 2026

The teaching of R.E. is based on the Derbyshire Agreed Religious Education Syllabus 2025-30. This requires that pupils be taught religions that include Christianity as well as a range of others. We aim to study other religions to provide contrast and comparison and broaden our children's experiences and wisdom.

Parents have the right to withdraw their children from these lessons, as they do from the school assembly. Some Personal, Social and Health Education (P.S.H.E.) is closely connected to R.E. lessons and assembly / collective worship.

RELIGIOUS AFFILIATION

The school is a Church of England Voluntary Controlled School. This means that we have Foundation Governors from the Parochial Church Council, one of whom should normally be the Vicar.
