### Year 3 end of year expectations

#### Writing

- Use conjunctions (when, so, before, after, while, because).
- Use time connectives (e.g. then, next, soon).
- Use prepositions (e.g. before, after, during, in, because of).
- Use a range of adjectives to add detail and interest.
- Use a range of verb forms appropriately (e.g. past, present and progressive forms).
- Begin to use the perfect form of verbs to mark relationships of time and cause.
- Use inverted commas to punctuate direct speech (with some accuracy).
- Group ideas into paragraphs around a theme.
- Write under headings and sub-headings.
- Write in a neat, legible, joined style with letters of consistent size.

#### Reading

- Read aloud with fluency and appropriate expression.
- Comment on the way characters relate to one another.
- Identify key information in a sentence or paragraph.
- Draw inferences such as inferring characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions.
- Discuss how punctuation supports meaning.
- Recognise how different word types (e.g. pronouns, nouns, adverbs) are used in texts.
- Explain the difference between adjectives and verbs and their impact on a sentence.
- Summarise the main ideas from a text.

#### Speaking and Listening

- Develop ideas and feelings through sustained talk.
- Show good awareness of the listener.

- Use a different style, tone and volume when speaking to a larger audience.
- Listen carefully and make relevant comments in response to what has been said.
- Suggest different ideas related to a specific problem.
- Summarise the main issues associated with a talk.
- Ask and answer questions to support understanding.

## Mathematics

- Compare and order numbers up to 1000.
- Read and write all numbers to 1000 in digits and words.
- Find 10 or 100 more/less than a given number.
- Count in multiples of 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10, 50 and 100.
- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables.
- Recognise place value of any 3-digit number.
- Add and subtract:
  - 3-digit and single digit numbers ( $345+8$ )
  - 3-digit numbers and multiples of 10 ( $682+50$ )
  - 3-digit numbers and multiples of 100 ( $725+300$ )
- Add and subtract numbers with up to 3 digits using an efficient written method (column).
- Use inverse to check.
- Multiply 2-digits by 1-digit ( $37\times 4$ ).
- Count up/down in tenths.
- Compare and order fractions with same denominator.
- Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator, including whole numbers.
- Know pairs of fractions that total 1.
- Tell time using 12 and 24 hour clocks; and using roman numerals.
- Tell time to nearest minute.
- Know number of days in each month and year.
