Our Minimum Entitlement

We aim for every pupil to:

- Access a range of enrichment experiences across all five areas during their primary education.
- Take part in clubs, enrichment activities or additional opportunities beyond the taught curriculum.
- Participate in educational visits each year.
- Perform or present to an audience.
- Contribute to the life of the school or wider community.

- Undertake leadership or responsibility opportunities appropriate to their age.
- Experience outdoor learning regularly.
- Attend a residential visit during Key Stage 2.

Inclusion and Equity

We are committed to ensuring that enrichment is accessible to all pupils. We actively monitor participation and seek to remove barriers that may prevent children from taking part. Particular attention is given to ensuring that disadvantaged pupils, pupils with SEND and other potentially vulnerable groups are fully included in our enrichment offer.
